REFERENCE FOR AMELIA COOK OF EQUINE FILMS

In 2018 I directed the television feature film KIWI. Centred around a humble family and their much loved horse (Kiwi), it tells the story of how this special thoroughbred, largely written off by the racing world, took out one of the most famous wins in Melbourne Cup history. On this job Amelia was our horse master.

I had never worked with horses before, and to be honest was a bit scared of them. Amelia was the perfect horse master to have with me on this film. Within a short while I was relaxed around these beautiful creatures and grew to love them. Many of the cast were in the same boat as me, most of them had never ridden a horse before. Amelia's calmness was a godsend for us all and I would work with her again in a heartbeat.

Kiwi was in fact a lead character in this film, and Amelia's ability to get the nuances required from an animal like this was quite remarkable. We created some incredibly touching scenes with her help. At the other end of the drama spectrum on this film, was our challenge to re-create the 1983 Melbourne Cup, a race with a field of 24 horses. Due to budget constraints we had only 12 and Amelia's ability (working closely with the jockeys) to choreograph a race that gave the illusion of the real event was quite extraordinary. Her relationship with the crew, production team and actors was first class and her care for the horses was excellent.

Kiwi was an extremely challenging but rewarding project, and is a film I am very proud off. I have Amelia to thank for much of this. Horses racing, thundering down the beach, galloping up hills, rounding up sheep and acting - she took all these challenged in her stride and delivered on all fronts.

I would have no hesitation in recommending her for any film project. In fact, I would snap her up quick smart before someone else does.
